Elvis at 21 Trivia Contest

By entering this Smithsonian contest you irrevocably agree to be bound by the following rules:

1. Entrants must be 18 years of age or older.
2. To enter, entrant must submit his or her correct answer to a Smithsonian tweet containing a trivia question. There will be 10 contest tweets over the duration of the *Elvis at 21* national tour, beginning in November 2010 through March 2012. The time of the trivia tweets will be announced to followers and fans ahead of time on the Smithsonian Institution Traveling Exhibition Service's *Elvis at 21* Facebook and Twitter pages.
3. One entry per person per trivia question. Multiple entries void.
4. The Smithsonian will award 10 prizes total over the course of 10 trivia questions. The prize is a copy of *Elvis 1956*, signed by Alfred Wertheimer. If prize becomes unavailable for any reason, the Smithsonian reserves the right to substitute a prize of like or equal value. Winners may not request prize substitution.
5. To win, entrant must be the first to post a return tweet responding with a correct answer to the Smithsonian's trivia question tweet. The Smithsonian will judge entries and select the winners in its sole discretion based on the merits of the tweet response and order of responses as it receives them. Winners will be notified via direct message. If winner does not respond to the notification within five business days another winner will be chosen. Failure to respond within five business days means the winner forfeits the prize.
6. One prize per person. Winners may enter as many trivia questions as they like, but are disqualified from winning a second time.
7. Entrants give the Smithsonian permission to use the entrant's name, image, and likeness to publicize the Smithsonian and its exhibit, *Elvis at 21*, if the entrant is selected as winner and accepts the prize.
8. Winner is responsible for all taxes on the prize, if any.
9. All entrants will hold the Smithsonian, its officers, directors, employees, and volunteers harmless from and against all claims of any nature arising in connection with your participation in the contest or receipt of the prize. The Smithsonian, its officers, directors, employees, and volunteers, is not liable for any costs, damages, injuries, or other claims incurred as a result of entrants' participation in the contest or winner's acceptance and usage of the prize.
10. Winners may be required to execute an affidavit of eligibility and publicity release as a condition of receiving the prize.

The Smithsonian reserves the right to cancel the contest or modify these rules at any time at its discretion. In the event of a dispute regarding the winners, the Smithsonian reserves the right to award or not award the prizes in its sole discretion. By entering this contest, entrants agree to be bound by these Rules and the decisions of the Smithsonian, which are final and binding in all respects.
